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LifeSpan Resources to Host “Falling Through the Cracks: Medicaid Transitions in Indiana” Town Hall

SELLERSBURG, IN — LifeSpan Resources will host a public town hall meeting titled *“Falling Through the Cracks: Medicaid Transitions in Indiana”* on Tuesday, May 26, 2026, from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at Ivy Tech Community College in Sellersburg, Indiana.

The event is designed to give Medicaid recipients, caregivers, providers, and community members an opportunity to share concerns and experiences regarding ongoing Medicaid changes and service transitions occurring across Indiana.

The meeting will focus on the growing challenges facing individuals who rely on Medicaid-funded services and the providers who support them. Attendees will have the opportunity to speak directly with elected officials and members of the media about the impact these changes are having on vulnerable populations throughout the state.

Discussion topics will include:

- Increasing Medicaid waitlists, with more than 20,000 individuals reportedly waiting for services
- Decreases in services and longer wait times for assistance
- Lack of compassionate care
- Medicaid terminations and ongoing program changes

The town hall is intended for:

- Providers
- Former and current Medicaid Waiver and PathWays for Aging clients
- Social workers
- Caregivers and family members

The event will be moderated by Dr. Melissa Fry, a professor of Public & Applied Sociology at Indiana University Southeast.
